Background and Education:

Before coming to Nanjing in September 2008, Dr. Webb was Lecturer on Social Studies at Harvard University. He was a faculty advisor for the Harvard Globalization Project and a Visiting Scholar at the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. At the Center, Professor Webb teaches Comparative Politics, the Modernity and World Social Thought Seminar, Perspectives on Globalization, and the Politics of Rural Development. He has also taught the bilingual First Year MA Tutorial with Professor Feng Chuan. Dr. Webb's linguistic skills include Chinese, Arabic, Hindi, Spanish and French.

Professor Webb received his A.B. in Social Studies from Harvard University, and his M.A. and Ph.D. in Politics from Princeton University.

Publications:

Dr. Webb's research and teaching interests center around global cultural issues including liberalism and anti-liberalism, classics of political and social theory, world political thought, modernity and its critics, rural politics and alternative development.

He is the author of *Beyond the Global Culture War* (2006) and *A Path of Our Own: An Andean Village and Tomorrow's Economy of Values* (2009) and is currently working on a book about encounters among civilizations and an alternative approach to cosmopolitanism. It will examine pre-modern encounters between civilizations to generate lessons for an alternative, non-liberal kind of globalization in our time.

工作经历和教育背景:

Webb 教授于 2008 年 9 月来中心任教。之前，他是哈佛大学社会研究学方向的讲师。Webb 教授还曾经是哈佛大学全球化项目的指导老师和美国艺术与科学研究院的访问学者。在中心，Webb 教授开设的课程包括：比较政治、现代性和世界社会思潮、全球化研究和农村发展政治。同时，他还和冯川教授合作开设一年级硕士生辅导课。Webb 教授掌握多种语言，包括：汉语，阿拉伯语，印度语，西班牙语和法语。

Webb 教授从哈佛大学获得社会研究学学士学位，从普林斯顿大学获得政治学硕士和博士学位。

出版作品:

Webb 教授的研究和教学主要围绕全球性文化问题，包括：自由主义和反自由主义，古典政治学和社会学原理，世界政治思潮，现代性以及对其的评论，农村政治学和变通性发展。他的著作包括：2006 年出版的《超越全球的文化战争》和 2009 年的《我们的道路——安第斯村落和明日的经济价值》。目前，他正在写作一本关于文明的碰撞和世界主义的可替代方法。他将分析现代化之前的文明冲突，从而探寻新的可替换的非自由主义的全球化方式。
